



CORRESPONDENCE ASPIRING MINISTERS PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

House of David Schools of Ministry: Ministry Development Program is not a theologically accredited Program. It is a program designed for those who desire to walk in the Spirit and become licensed Ministers of the Gospel. This Program's focus is **Ministry Development** therefore the teachings in the program are designed to help you develop the ministry God has called you to. For this reason, each student who desires to be licensed **MUST** develop a ministry to receive a ministerial license.

Completion of the Aspiring Ministers Program requires **12 months** of dedication and commitment from each student. Students will be required to complete the following:

- **9 months of course study** - which includes ministry training and the required assignments
- **3 months of Ministry Service** – during this time, students put their ministry into action.
- **2 Spiritual Enrichment courses** – these correspondence courses require students to complete 2 additional assignments per week and are sent in along with your monthly assignments. Please see the Spiritual Enrichment Course page included in this package for your choice of courses.
 - ❖ Students must complete one 12-week course and one 16-week course during their 9 months of course study.
 - ❖ A new course will be mailed upon completion of the first.

This is a contribution based program. Students make contributions which cover their tuition and a one-time application processing contribution. All shipping and handling is included in the contribution pricing detailed in this package. If there is a financial hardship, please contact our office.

For students who are looking to grow in the Lord and **not** receive a Ministerial license, the program can be completed for a Certificate of Completion. For these students the course length will be the nine months of course study only, they will not have to develop a ministry nor complete the three month Ministry Service. However, the same level of dedication and commitment and course requirements for their portion are placed on them.

There are 4 sections within this program, they are:

SECTION #1: Kingdom Character for Righteousness: Discipleship Program

SECTION #2: Ministry Concentration

SECTION #3: Ministry Development & Implementation

SECTION #4: Commitment of Ministry Service

SECTION #1: Kingdom Character for Righteousness

This prerequisite course will develop within each student a foundation upon which the Lord can build upon within their life. These teachings will help prepare you to become a minister from the inside out. It will teach you about Biblical Christian Character so that you can be a vessel of righteousness for the Master's use.

SECTION #2: Ministry Concentration

You will receive focused teachings to equip and develop you in your area of concentration. It will also develop within you an understanding of that particular anointing and how it functions in your life so that you can be an effective witness with miracles, signs and wonders following. You can only do **1** of the 5 areas of concentration at a time. **You do not have to choose a concentration immediately to begin the program.**

We have 5 areas of concentration:

General Ministers Program

"But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you." Matthew 6:33

If you are a teacher of the Word of God or desire to be more fluent in the revelation of foundational truths, this program will refresh and equip you. You will explore how to understand and operate in the Gifts of the Spirit. You will learn about the character of God and His requirements, in order to receive an anointing that will birth a supernatural ministry. You will be taught how to become a vessel filled with the divine presence of the Lord, so that the Word of God can be dispensed with power and understanding. This will cause you to develop a ministry that produces dynamic results for the Kingdom of God.

Minister of Evangelism Program

"But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them." 2 Corinthians 4:3-4

Those who are called to the area of Evangelism have a strong desire to win souls to Christ. Their speech and preaching are not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power that the faith of the lost would not stand in the wisdom of man, but in the power of God. If you seek to minister in this venue, signs and wonders must follow you to win the lost to salvation. This program will build your faith to see signs follow as you preach. You will learn how to explain Christ's sacrifice and boldly declare that He is the only way to salvation, through demonstration. You will also learn how to evangelize to those of different religions through the Word of God so that you can do the work of an evangelist and make full proof of your ministry.

Minster of Intercession and Prayer

"If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land." 2 Chronicles 7:14

If you feel the Lord has called you to pray and intercede on behalf of others, a particular area or territory then this program will offer you the necessary tools to see results as you pray. The teachings within this program will help you understand the difference between prayer and intercession. You will also learn the dynamics of prayer and intercession, so that you can learn how to identify the tactics of the enemy and destroy his plans. As an intercessor, you will learn how to live a life of consecration through the study of the life of Daniel. This will help you understand the importance of raising a standard of righteousness in your life which in result will cause you to become a righteous believer, whose effectual and fervent prayers avail much.

Minister of Healing & Deliverance

"And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand. Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give." Matthew 10:7-8

This program facilitates those that believe that they are called to a ministry of healing and/or deliverance. These teachings will help you gain an understanding of the operation of the spiritual gifts in these areas. You will learn the dynamics of spiritual warfare and how to identify what spirits are in operation in various instances. You will also learn how to address the root of sickness and disease, and instruct others in receiving and maintaining their healing. As you matriculate you will become a vessel that will heal the broken hearted and deliver the captives.

Minister of Music and Song

"Praise ye the LORD. Praise God in his sanctuary: praise him in the firmament of his power. Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness. Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp. Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD." Psalms 150:1-3, 6

This program is for musicians who desire to have a supernatural music ministry. You will learn how to line up your character and life with your gift to see God's glory manifest. This will produce a music ministry that exhorts and edifies the people of God. When one ministers in music, God's presence should enter, causing great signs and wonders, healing and deliverance to occur. This program does not teach music; rather it magnifies the results of a righteous minister of music and song.

SECTION #3: Ministry Development & Implementation

Within your concentration you will receive teachings designed to help you confidently, identify the call of God on your life. You will also complete the "Operating In and Developing Ministry" course and learn how to implement your call by creating a ministry strategy. You will be required to do hands on ministerial work in the form of ministerial projects including but not limited to writing a sermon, evangelizing and praying for people.

SECTION #4: Commitment of Ministry Service

After completing your ministry strategy you will be required to complete a 3 month Commitment of Ministry Service. During this time, you will be completing progress reports that show how your ministry is functioning. These progress reports must be in direct correlation with the ministry the Lord develops within you during the course of the program and what your ministry strategy is based on. *They ensure that the ministry you have developed is successfully employed. During this time you will receive Ministry support to further fortify your ministry. This includes ministerial counseling and prayer support, etc...* **During these 3 months you will continue to send your monthly tuition contribution.**

****Please be advised for students who receive a ministerial license, you will have the legal right to minister and perform tasks that a minister of the Gospel would do such as perform marriages or funerals. **This license is not however a Pastoral license.***** If God has called you to the Pastorate and told you to prepare, this program is a good start. For more information on the Pastorate and Pastoral licensing please call our office at 321-263-0352.*

PROGRAM COMPLETION

At the end of the 12 months you will be interviewed by our Ministry Licensing Board, and following your successful interview you will be invited to Graduation and receive your Ministry license.

Following the completion of the Aspiring Ministers Program and receiving your ministers license, we are here to help further your development as a Minister of the Gospel and *ensure that the ministry you have developed is successfully employed.* During this time you will receive Ministry support to further fortify your ministry. Each minister will have access to House of David Ministerial Materials. These ministerial materials include strategies, teaching materials, ministerial counseling and prayer support.

ASPIRING MINISTERS COURSE REQUIREMENTS SIMPLE OVERVIEW

I. Homework

1. Each month we will mail you all of the assignments you are to complete for that month.
2. You will have 5-7 assignments per week (this does not include the Spiritual Enrichment course requirements) each month to complete.
3. You should set aside 3 or more hours per week to study and complete assignments.

II. Exams

1. Exams will consist of the things that you have learned from the reading of the assigned books and the lessons for that period.
2. There are two exams and a Final throughout the course of the program.

III. Additional Assignments

Summaries:

1. **You must submit a summary** of what you have learned from the Ministry Development lessons and how you will apply these teachings in your life and ministry.

Questionnaires:

2. **Periodically you will be given Ministry Development Questionnaires which will help you to identify and convey your ministerial development throughout the program.**

IV. Ministry Strategy

1. **Before beginning your commitment of ministry service and licensing**, you are required to complete in detail a ministry strategy for the ministry you have developed.

V. Spiritual Maintenance

1. We ask that you seek God out in prayer at least, or a minimum of ½ and hour to 1 hour per day (more is preferred.)
2. We ask that you fast at least 1 to 3 days per week.
3. We also would suggest that you limit your television watching, Internet browsing, newspaper reading, to 3 to 5 hours per week maximum (as well as secular book reading). If you use the telephone a lot please limit your time on it. Increase your reading of the Word and time with God.
4. **All students are required to be in fellowship with a church to be in the program. If you do not have a Church home, you are required to become a part of our correspondence membership. As a correspondence member, we ask that you give your tithe as you would at a local church. Each week you will be emailed our Sunday lesson and you will be contacted by a House of David Minister at least once a month. You can send your tithe to House of David Ministries via check or money order or via our website at www.riversofrevival.com. We truly believe that tithing is a basic principle, in which all ministry or potential ministers should follow. (Malachi 3: 8-10)**

VI. Program Contribution

1. **At the end of every 4 weeks** we ask that you send your monthly tuition contribution along with your completed assignments for that month. You can send your contributions via check or money order made out to **HOD Five Fold Network** to **PO Box 607548 Orlando, FL 32860**. This recommendation form will complete your application. If you do not have a recommendation, your application will not be reviewed. The recommendation form must be mailed in along with your completed application, (in a separate sealed envelope), unless your Pastor chooses to mail it separately.

****Important note:** Before giving the recommendation to your Pastor, please complete the portion of the form at the very top (it begins "Applicant") and then give the form to your Pastor to complete.

Claims of misconduct will be thoroughly investigated prior to dismissal.
